




# WMO Workforce: 349 Staff

#### **REGULAR AND EXTRABUDGETARY STAFF**




WMO currently has 349 staff on regular and extrabudgetary funding.








## Professional Staff by Grade Level




#### Gender Distribution and Age Profile of Staff





### Geographic Location Geographic Distribution of Staff


