




Additional Payments *May 2024*

- ➤ Total additional payments of CHF 10.4 million during May 2024
- ➤ Total outstanding at 31 May 2024 is CHF 43.8 million, which is CHF 4.4 million *lower* than at 31 May 2023

Summary

Challenges:

- ➤ Payments by Members slowed through April 2024 as compared to April 2023
- ➤ Fewer Members have made payments in 2024 as compared to 2023
- ➤ Outstanding amounts at 30 April represent 78% of 2024 assessment
- ➤ Increase of Members who have lost voting rights



Summary

Positives:

- ➤ 2024 started with a lower level of arrears than at the beginning of 2023
- ➤ Significant payments received in May 2024 outstanding at 31 May represented 63% of 2024 assesment
- General Fund cash position remains strong

That the Executive Council urge Members with unpaid contributions to settle their dues as early as possible, as delayed settlement may reduce the efficient and effective implementation of the approved activities of WMO and may expose the Secretariat to the risk of not being in a position to pay its obligations to third parties when they become due.
