

Financial situation of WMO

Beginning in Q1, Secretary-General implemented cost containment measures, especially in:







+ CHF 5 million

FORECAST 2025 SAVINGS FROM COST CONTAINMENT





Status of assessed contributions as of 31 Agust

- 2025 started with same level of arrears as 2024
- Significantly lower level of arrears payment in 2025, as compared to prior years (only 8% paid)
- Payments of 2025 assessment higher than in 2024 due to some Members advancing payment (+13%)
- At 31 August, outstanding amounts represent 69% of the 2025 assessment
- Fewer Members have made payments in 2025, as compared to 2024






Regular budget cash - including forecast for remainder of 2025

Regular budget cash - including forecast for 2025/2026


2026 forecast is based upon:





Cost containment measures in place throughout 2026


Members maintaining payment patterns from 2025
