Election of RA III officers vote process Mail in vote

- 1. The presiding officer opens the e-voting meeting, identifies the tellers and invites the Secretariat to present the email voting proposal to the Regional Association III (RA III) members;
- 2. The presiding officer invites the Chair of the Nomination Committee to present the Report;
- 3. The names of the candidates are verified by the tellers and then displayed on the screen;
- 4. The presiding officer declares the vote OPEN. The voting round will last 10 minutes;
- 5. RA III members or their alternates send the name of the preferred candidate by email to the Office of the Legal Counsel, at LegalCounsel@wmo.int (email subject: "RA III Vote-president/vice-president")
- 6. The presiding officer declares the vote CLOSED;
- 7. The Office of the Legal Counsel confirms receipt of votes which are counted in collaboration with the tellers;
- 8. The presiding officer announces the results confirmed by the tellers and Office of the Legal Counsel;
- 9. If no candidate has obtained the required majority (*simple majority*), the candidate that received the least number of votes shall be removed from the list and a following voting round shall be held for the remaining candidates;
- 10. The presiding officer resumes the voting process from steps 3 to 9 until a candidate receives the required majority (*simple majority*) and is declared elected.
